



**GEORGIA-PACIFIC TO BUILD STATE-OF-THE-ART LUMBER PRODUCTION FACILITY IN TALLADEGA, ALABAMA**  
**\$100 Million Plant to Create More Than 100 New Jobs**

ATLANTA, September 13, 2017 – Georgia-Pacific announced today a new lumber production facility in Talladega, Alabama. Construction on the \$100 million, 300,000-square foot, technologically advanced plant is scheduled to begin immediately with an anticipated startup in late 2018. Once it is fully operational, the plant will employ more than 100 full-time employees and generate an estimated \$5 million in annual payroll.
